


RESOLUTION NO. HEPB-2009-63

A RESOLUTION OF THE HISTORIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL PRESERVATION BOARD ("HEPB") OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA, RECOMMENDING TO THE PLANNING ADVISORY BOARD AND THE MIAMI CITY COMMISSION TO DESIGNATE BISCAYNE BOULEVARD FROM APPROXIMATELY THE MIAMI RIVER TO NE 36<sup>TH</sup> STREET, AS A SCENIC TRANSPORTATION CORRIDOR AND TO TAKE IMMEDIATE STEPS TO NOTIFY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION OF THE CITY'S INTENT TO DESIGNATE THE BOULEVARD, ASKING FDOT TO REVIEW THEIR PLANS, AND REVISE THEM AS NECESSARY TO RETAIN THE INTEGRITY OF BISCAYNE BOULEVARD AS A SCENIC TRANSPORTATION CORRIDOR.


