Resolution:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MIAMI PLANNING ADVISORY BOARD RECOMMENDING APPROVAL TO THE MIAMI CITY COMMISSION, OF AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY ALONG BISCAYNE BOULEVARD FROM APPROXIMATELY THE MIAMI RIVER NORTH TO NORTHEAST 36TH STREET, THE RIGHT-OF-WAY WIDTH IS AS FOLLOWS: FROM SOUTHEAST 4TH STREET TO SOUTHEAST 2ND STREET (100'), FROM SOUTHEAST 2ND STREET TO NORTHEAST 6TH STREET (230'), FROM NORTHEAST 6TH STREET TO NORTHEAST 8TH STREET (168'), FROM NORTHEAST 8TH STREET TO NORTHEAST 9TH STREET (150'), FROM NORTHEAST 9TH STREET TO NORTHEAST 12TH STREET (220'), NORTHEAST 12TH STREET TO NORTHEAST 36TH STREET (100'), AS A SCENIC TRANSPORTATION CORRIDOR PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 17, SECTION 17-31 (b) (3) OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA, ENTITLED "ENVIRONMENTAL PRESERVATION DISTRICTS," AMENDING THE OFFICIAL HISTORIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL PRESERVATION ATLAS OF THE CITY OF MIAMI; SUBJECT TO LIMITATIONS AS SET FORTH; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
